

《China seeks stronger friendship with Myanmar》

BEIJING, March 15 (Xinhua) -- China on Tuesday congratulated Myanmar on its election of U Htin Kyaw as president.

"China looks forward to strengthening cooperation with Myanmar's new government," Foreign Ministry spokesperson Lu Kang said at a regular press briefing.

He said that China will continue to support Myanmar's efforts toward stability, development and ethnic reconciliation, and described the two countries as "friendly neighbors."
