In badminton, it was a tough day for China's mixed doubles teams. Both pairs lost in the semifinals. Defending champions Zhang Nan and Zhao Yunlei fell to Indonesia's Tontowi Ahmad and Liliyana Natsir. And the Chinese duo of Xu Chen and Ma Jin were knocked out by Malaysian pair, Chan Peng Soon, and Goh Liu Ying.

Compatriot Cao progresses into semi-final stage

In the pool, China's He Chao failed to reach the semi-final of the men's three-meter springboard event. The diver too inconsistent to progress but his compatriot Cao Yuan advanced to the semi's set for Tuesday. •

33-year-old defeats Turkey's Kayaalp in 130kg final

In men's 130-kilogram wrestling, Cuba's Mijain Lopez Nunez defeated Turkey's Riza Kayaalp by six points in the final. The 33-year-old captured his **third successive** Olympic gold medal. Nunez has also been crowned world champion on five occasions. •
