The Beijing Customs held an open day activity at the Sniffer Dogs base of Anti-Smuggling Bureau of the General Administration of Customs, ahead of the International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking. Since the establishment, the sniffer dogs in this base has helped crack more than 121 cases and detect 264 kilograms of drugs.



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
