

《小满用英语怎么说？小满英文介绍》

“小满”用英语怎么说?

1. Grain Buds

这个表达法用“Buds”(花蕾，也可引申为正在发展的初期状态)来描述“小满”这一节气中，谷物正处于成长但尚未成熟的状态。虽然“Buds”通常与花朵相关，但在这里它被用来比喻谷物处于成长的初期阶段，与“小满”的含义相吻合。

例句：In the Grain Buds season, the grains of summer crops begin to be plump but not

yet ripe.

在小满时节，夏熟作物的籽粒开始饱满但还未成熟。

2. Lesser Fullness of Grain

这个表达法直接翻译了“小满”的字面意义。“Lesser Fullness”指的是未满但接近满的状态，而“of Grain”则明确指出了这是关于谷物的状态。

这种表达法非常准确地传达了“小满”节气中谷物接近成熟但尚未成熟的特点。

例句：Lesser Fullness of Grain signifies the grains are becoming full but are not yet ripe, reflecting a state of almost fullness.

3. Grain Full

虽然这个表达法没有直接包含“小”的含义，但“Grain Full”仍然可以用来描述“小满”这一节气。

“Full”可以被理解为接近完全饱满但还未达到最终状态的意思。不过，相较于其他两种表达法，它可能稍显笼统。

例句：Grain Full is a solar term that marks the time when the grains of summer crops are beginning to fill out, though not yet fully ripe.

小满英文介绍

The Grain in Ear, also known as Xiaoman, is the eighth traditional Chinese solar term, marking the transition from spring to summer. It occurs when the sun reaches the Tropic of Cancer, usually around May 20th or 21st in the Gregorian calendar. This solar term signifies a time of abundant rainfall and growing warmth, as well as the nearing of the harvest season.
