例句：The students were required to submit their assignments by the end of the week.

例句：The new product is superior in quality to its competitors.

temper [ˈtempə] 脾气，情绪

例句：His temper often gets the better of him in heated arguments.

testify [ˈtestɪfaɪ] 证实;说明

例句：The witness testified that she saw the accident happen.

threaten [ˈθreɪtn] 威胁，恐吓;预示(某事)

例句：The heavy rain threatened to cancel the outdoor event.

transform [træns f rm] 使改变，使转化，使变化

例句：The new technology has transformed the way we communicate.

trend [trend] 趋势，倾向

例句：The latest fashion trend is for brightly colored clothing.

例句：The museum's collection includes a unique piece of artwork.

例句：The hotel can accommodate up to 100 guests.

accustom [k st m] 使习惯

例句：It took some time for the family to get accustomed to the new house.

acknowledge [k n l d]

承认...的权威(或主张);告知(信件、礼物等)已收到，确认;对(礼物)表示感谢

例句：The company acknowledged receipt of the customer's complaint and promised to take action.

acquire [kwa r] 取得，获得;学到

例句：She acquired a second language while living abroad.

aggressive [d s v] 侵略的，好斗的;[褒]有进取心的

例句：The company's aggressive marketing strategy has helped it to gain market share.

alien [e li n] 外国的;不相容的;(from) 相异的, 陌生的;外侨, 外来者;外星人

例句: Many aliens living in the country have applied for citizenship.
