1. alter / ' ɔ : lt ə r/ 改变，变更

例句：The scientist altered the experiment to test a new hypothesis.

2. ambiguous / æ m ' b ɪ gju : ə s/ 含糊不清的，不明确的;引起歧义的，模棱两可的

例句：The interpreter said the ambassador's comment was ambiguous and needed clarification.

3. amuse / ə ' mju : z/ 逗乐，逗笑;(提供)消遣，(使)娱乐

例句：The comedian's routine amused the audience with its幽默 and wit.

4. appliance / ə ' pla ɪ ə ns/ (家用)电器，器械，用具

例句：She bought a new appliance for the kitchen to replace the old refrigerator.

5. arouse / ə ' ra ʊ z/ 引起，激起;唤醒，唤起

例句：The teacher's question aroused the students' curiosity about the topic.

6. assist / ə ' s ɪ st/ 协助，援助

例句：The nurse offered to assist the doctor with the patient's examination.

7. bargain / ' b ɑ : rd ʒ ɪ n/ 议价;谈判;廉价货;买卖合同，协议，交易

例句：The shoppers bargained with the vendor for a better price on the souvenirs.

8. barrier / ' bæ r ɪ ə r/ 栅栏，屏障;障碍(物)

例句：The language barrier made it difficult for the travelers to communicate with the locals.

9. basis / ' beɪ sɪ s/ 基础, 根据

例句: The agreement was based on a mutual respect and a common goal.

10. beam /bi : m/ (横)梁;(光线的)束, 柱;发光;微笑

例句: The constructor checked the beam's strength to ensure the building's stability.

11. boom /bu : m/ 发出隆隆声;兴旺, 迅速发展;繁荣, 兴旺

例句: The city's economy boomed after the construction of the new highway.

12. border / ' bɔ : rd ə r/ 边界, 国界;与...接壤;接近

例句: The two countries share a long border that stretches across mountains and plains.

13. brief /bri : f/ 简短的, 简洁的;简介

例句: The lawyer gave a brief overview of the case before the trial began.

14. budget / ' bʌ dʒ ɪ t/ 预算;(for)做预算;低廉的, 便宜的

例句: The family budgeted their monthly expenses to ensure they could save for their vacation.

15. campaign /kæm ' peɪ n/ 战役;活动竞选, 运动

例句: The political campaign heated up as the election day approached.

16. candidate / ' kændɪ d ə t/ 候选人;申请求职者;报考者

例句: The candidate for the university presidency presented his vision for the institution's future.

17. capable / ' keɪ p ə bl/ 有能力的, 有本领的;[贬]干得出来的, 敢于...的

例句: The team was capable of handling the project, despite the tight deadline.

18. certify / ' sɜ : rtɪ faɪ / 证实;发证书(或执照)

例句: The quality control department certifies that all products meet the company's standards.

19. chronic / ' kr ɒ n ɪ k/ (疾病)长期的, 慢性的;积习难改的;严重的, 坏的

例句: The doctor diagnosed the patient with a chronic condition that would require long-term treatment.

20. clarify / ' klær ɪ fa ɪ / 澄清, 阐明

例句: The spokesperson clarified the company's position on the environmental issue.

21. client / ' kla ɪ ə nt/ (诉讼)委托人;顾客

例句: The attorney-client privilege protects the confidentiality of communications between lawyer and client.

22. combat / ' k ɒ mbæt/ 战斗, 搏斗, 格斗;

例句: The soldiers were trained to engage in combat situations with precision and courage.

23. command /k ə ' mænd/ 命令;指挥, 统帅;俯瞰;

例句: The general issued a command to retreat when the unit was surrounded by the enemy.

24. conceal /k ə n ' si : l/ 隐藏, 隐瞒, 隐蔽

例句: The witness concealed the evidence from the police to protect their own safety.

25. concentrate / ' k ɒ nsntre ɪ t/ 专注, 专心;集中;浓缩

例句: To improve his exam scores, the student decided to concentrate more during study sessions.

26. confidence / ' k ɒ nf ɪ d ə ns/ 信任;信心, 自信;秘密, 机密

例句: The therapist built rapport with the client, which increased the client ' s confidence in treatment.

27. congress / ' k ɒ ŋ gr ε s/ 代表大会;国会, 议会;

例句: The congresswoman spoke passionately about healthcare reform during the congressional hearing.

28.consist /k ə n ' s ɪ st/ 由…组成;在于;一致

例句：The ecosystem consists of a complex web of interactions between species and their environment.

29.constant / ' k ɒ n st ə nt/ 持续的，不断的，经常的;永恒的，不变的;常数，恒量

例句：The Earth ' s rotation is a constant factor that determines our day and night cycle.
