1. novel [' n ə : v ə l] ① 新颖的，新奇的

例句：The novel idea caught the attention of the investors.

2. novel [' n ə : v ə l] ② (长篇)小说

例句：She spent the weekend reading a novel.

3. obscure [ə b ' s k j ũ r] 模糊的，晦涩的;不出名的

例句：The author's early works are obscure and difficult to find.

4. opponent [ə ' p ə : n ə nt] 敌手，对手;反对者

例句：In a debate, the opponent's arguments must be carefully considered.

5. patch [p æ t ʃ] 补丁;小块土地;斑，块;在…上打补丁

例句：She sewed a patch on the torn jacket.

6. peak [pi : k] 山峰，山顶;最高点;最高的;达到顶峰

例句：The mountain peak was covered in snow.

7. personality [, p ɜ : r ' s ə n ə l t i] 人格，个性;名人

例句：He has a strong personality that commands attention.

8. principle [' pr i ns i p ə l] 原理，原则;信念

例句：She lives by the principle of honesty and integrity.

9. privacy [' pr i v ə si] 私事，隐私;隐居

例句：Every individual is entitled to privacy.

10. procedure [prəˈsiːdʒər] (办事)程序, 手续, 步骤

例句: The procedure for filing a lawsuit is complex.

11. prospect [ˈprɒspekts] 景色;前途, 前景;(for)勘探, 勘察

例句: The prospect of a promotion excited him.

12. radiate [ˈreɪdɪeɪt] 辐射, 放射;散布, 传播;散发, 发出;表现

例句: The sun radiates heat and light.

13. rank [ræŋk] 排, 横排;军衔;社会阶层;分等级;排列

例句: The soldiers stood in rank for the inspection.

14. recall [rɪˈkɔːl] 回忆, 回想;收回

例句: She had a sudden recall of her childhood.

15. refine [rɪˈfaɪn] 精炼, 精制, 提纯

例句: The process of refining crude oil produces many useful products.

16. refrain [rɪˈfreɪn] 抑制, 克制, 避免

例句: He refrained from commenting on the controversial issue.

17. regulate [ˈrɛɡjuleɪt] 控制;调节, 校准

例句: The government regulates the financial industry to prevent crises.

18. release [rɪˈliːs] 释放;发布, 发行;放开, 放松

例句: The company released a new version of the software.

19. relevant [ˈrɛvələnt] 有关的, 相应的

例句: Please provide relevant information to support your claim.

20. reliable [rɪˈlaɪəbl] 可靠的, 可信赖的

例句: A reliable source confirmed the news.

21. reluctant [rɪˈlʌktənt] 不情愿的, 勉强的

例句: He was reluctantly forced to accept the job offer.

22. remark [rɪˈmɑːrk] 评论;(on, upon)注意到, 察觉

例句: She made a remark about the quality of the food.

23. repel [rɪˈpel] 击退;排斥, 厌恶;抵制;拒绝

例句: The strong odor repelled the flies.

24. represent [ˌrɛprɪˈzɛnt] 作为…的代理或代表;象征, 表示;表现

例句: The union representative negotiated with the management.

25. reserve [rɪˈzɜːv] 保留, 储备;预定, 预约;储备物, 储备金;保留用地

例句: She reserved a table for dinner.

26. resist [rɪˈzɪst] 抵抗;抵制;忍得住

例句: It is important to resist temptation.

27. respond [rɪˈspɒnd] 回答, 答复;(to)响应

例句: He didn't respond to my question.

29. retain [rɪˈteɪn] 保持, 保留

例句: The company retained its top talent by offering competitive benefits.

30. revenue [ˈrɛvɪnjuː] 收入;税收

例句: The government collects revenue from taxes to fund public services.
