SHANGHAI, May 23 (Xinhua) -- Chinese President Xi Jinping has said that China should be a country that learns from other countries and civilizations and keeps an open mind in exchanges with foreign countries.

Xi made the remarks during a meeting with foreign experts in Shanghai on Thursday after the Conference on Interaction and Confidence-Building Measures in Asia.
