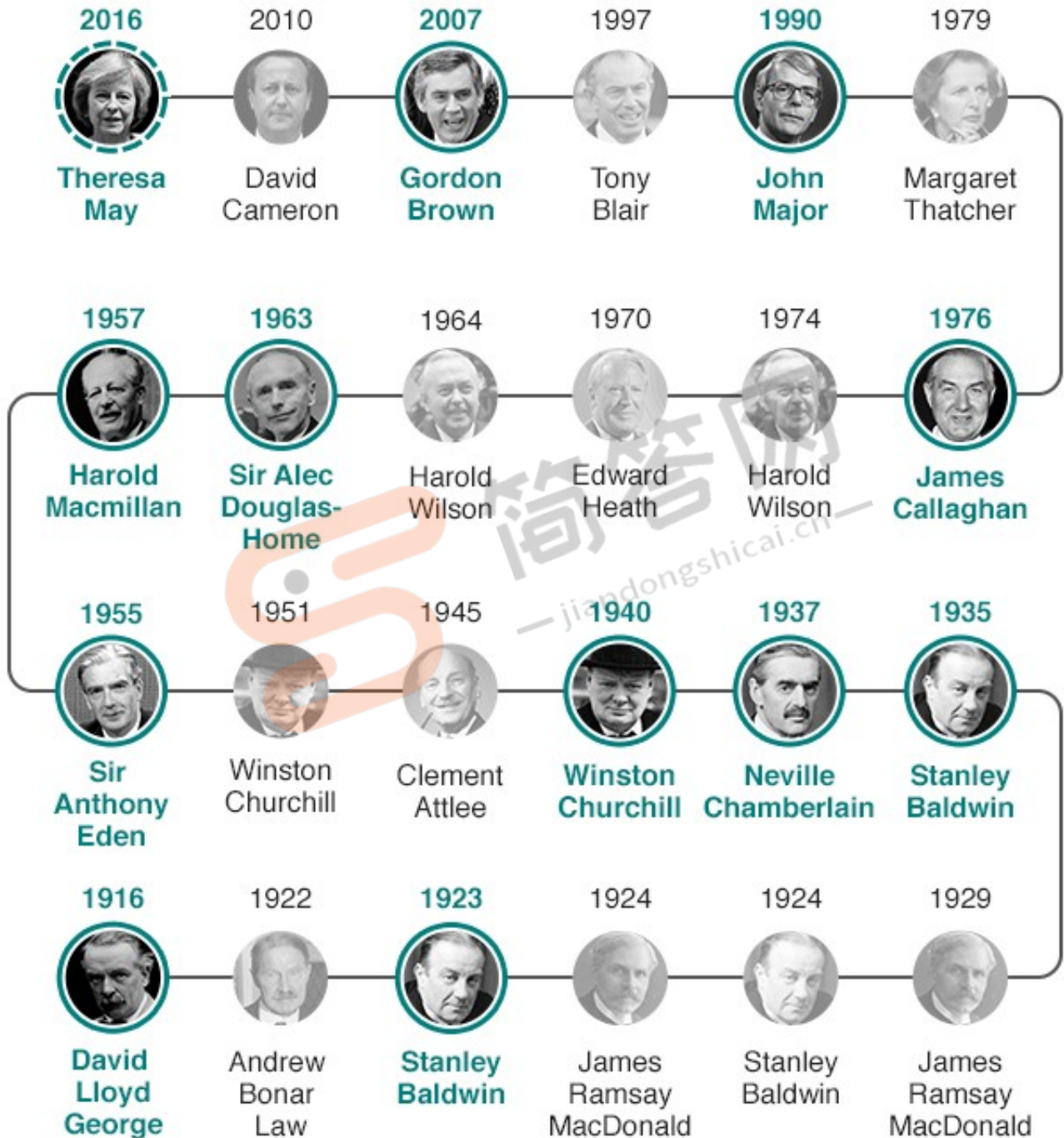
UK's PMs in the Past Century
