

《Premier: China to focus on targeted policies》

Chinese Premier Li Keqiang says the government has re-affirmed its stance to keep economic growth at a reasonable range, with a focus on targeted policies.

Li said that the government will improve economic policies through innovation and by enriching its tool kit. The premier also said that innovation is the key driver of China's ascension on the global value chain and its improvement in growth quality.

The premier pledged to shore up fiscal support for Chinese research and development while encouraging private

capital to improve the efficiency of technological innovation.
